4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-17.6-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is 6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7 54-17.6-02. Oil and gas research council purposes. There is created the oil and gas 8 research council. The purpose of the council is to coordinate a program designed to 9 demonstrate to the general public the importance of the state oil and gas exploration and 10 production industry, to encourage and promote the wise and efficient use of energy, to promote 11 environmentally sound exploration and production methods and technologies, to develop the 12 state's oil and gas resources, and to support research and educational activities concerning the 13 oil and natural gas exploration and production industry, and to promote innovation in safety, 14 enhancement of environment, and increase in education concerning the distribution of 15 petroleum products. 16 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 54-17.6-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is 17 amended and reenacted as follows: 18 54-17.6-04. Powers and duties of commission in managing and operating council. 19 The commission is granted all the powers necessary or appropriate to carry out and effectuate 20 the purposes of this chapter, including the power to: 21 Make grants or loans, and to provide other forms of financial assistance as 1. 22 necessary or appropriate, to qualified persons for research, development, 23 marketing, and educational projects, and processes or activities directly related to

1		the oil and gas exploration and, production, or refining industry, or the petroleum
2		marketing industry;
3	2.	Enter into contracts or agreements to carry out the purposes of this chapter,
4		including authority to contract for the administration of the oil and gas research,
5		development, marketing, and educational program;
6	3.	Keep accurate records of all financial transactions performed under this chapter;
7	4.	Cooperate with any private, local, state, or national commission, organization, or
8		agent, or group and to make contracts and agreements for programs benefiting the
9		oil and gas industry;
10	5.	Accept donations, grants, contributions, and gifts from any public or private source
11		and deposit such in the oil and gas research fund; and
12	6.	Make and explore orders, rules, and regulations necessary to effectuate the
13		purposes of this chapter.
