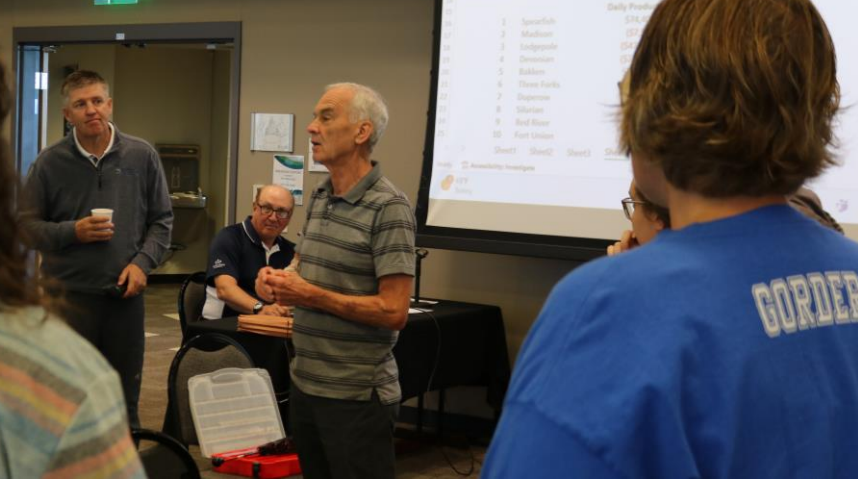

Timeline:

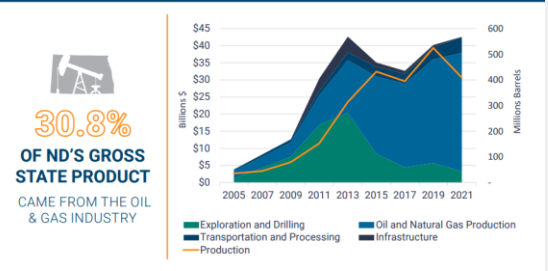
Data collection begins in the fall of odd years with the release of info in March of even years.

Distribution:

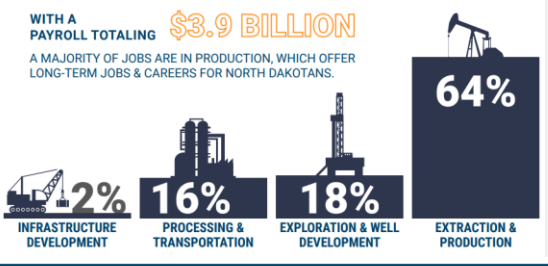
Results are shared via News Conferences, news releases, our Advancing the Possibilities Campaigns, our website, and collateral that is passed out at events.



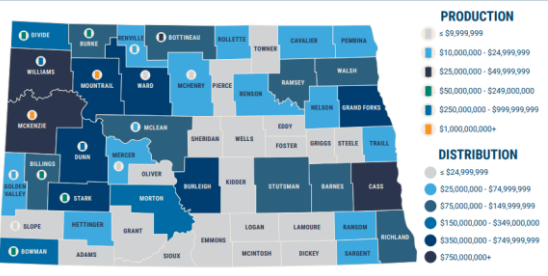
\$42.58 BILLION TOTAL ECONOMIC IMPACT IN 2021
