Up to 50 teachers are hosted for a 30hour seminar covering all aspects of the oil and gas industry.

Teachers also participate in a drilling and production site tours, along with other available facilities.

Companies, trade associations, local organizations, and colleges/universities facilitate up to 24 sessions for students 6-12.

Measure the impact on jobs, the economy, salaries and wages, and tax revenues, as well as how those taxes are distributed in our state.


Timeline:

\$42.58 BILLION TOTAL ECONOMIC IMPACT IN 2021


